Officer Training



RGMU Training Outline for Prospective Officer Candidates (POC)

Training Description:

This training will provide the necessary knowledge and experience for POC pilots to demonstrate their proficiency in leading other pilots as required for advanced to the lowest officer's ranks.

Topics and Objectives

Pilot's Manual

The POC must attain at least a 60% or better pass rate on an oral examination of the Pilot's manual as presented by his instructor.

The POC will be able to attain at least an 80% pass rate on an open book examination of the Pilot's manual

Officers' Manual

The POC must attain at least a 60% or better pass rate on an oral examination of the Officers' manual as presented by his instructor.

The POC will be able to attain at least an 80% pass rate on an open book examination of the Officers' manual

RGMU SOP

The POC must attain at least a 60% or better pass rate on an oral examination of the RGMU SOPs presented by his instructor.

The POC will be able to attain at least an 80% pass rate on an open book examination of the RGMU SOP

Tactics Manual

The POC must attain at least a 60% or better pass rate on an oral examination of the Tactics manual as presented by his instructor.

The POC will be able to attain at least an 80% pass rate on an open book examination of the Tactics manual

Final Exam

The POC then has to write the open book Officer's Exam and pass with 80% or better.

League Match Participation

The POC pilot will be able to organize all logistical aspects of a league match

The POC will be able to perform the duties of a backup DC in an FFP CNR match

The POC will be able to perform the duties of a DC in an FFP CNR match winning at least one of the 2(3) required drops.

Training Sessions

Before initiating this training session, the POC will be awarded the rank of **Warrant Officer**.

Training Session #1 - Pilot's Manual

Training Session #3 - RGMU Full SOP (Standard Operating Procedures)

Once the session is complete, the POC will receive an additional examination via email that may be completed “open-book” and then sent to the POC instructor for evaluation.

Instruction/Activities

- 2) Instructor will verbally examine the POC for knowledge of the RGMU SOP
- 3) Instructor will send the open-book examination via email to further examine the POC’s knowledge of the RGMU Full SOP.

Training Session #4 - Tactics Manual



This training requires a 30-minute session on TeamSpeak with the POC instructor to cover the fundamental aspects of the Tactics Manual and conduct a 10-item verbal examination. Once the session is complete, the POC will receive an additional examination via email that may be completed “open-book” and then sent to the POC instructor for evaluation.

Instruction/Activities

- 1) Instructor will cover the basics precepts of the Tactics manual
- 2) Instructor will verbally examine the POC for knowledge of the Tactics manual
- 3) Instructor will send the open-book examination via email to further examine the POC’s knowledge of the Tactics manual

Final Book Exam:



After the first 4 activities have been completed, the POC then has to write the Officer's Exam and pass with **80%** or better. Once the POC passes this exam, they are awarded the rank of **Leutenant JG**.



Training Session #5 - Handling Match Logistics

This training requires at least one 15 to 30 minute session with the POC instructor and an assigned Drop Commander to explain and delegate match responsibilities to the POC. The POC will be evaluated by the POC instructor and DC on his ability to fulfill FFP CNR match tasks and receive a brief textual evaluation of his performance once the match is complete.

Instruction/Activities


Instructor and DC will cover logistical responsibilities the POC must complete to include:


- a.** Scheduling at least one practice on and RGMU server for participating pilots
- b.** Organizing and recruiting RGMU pilots to act as an opposing team for the scheduled practice
- c.** Arrange for a server or server password to the PC hosting the match and communicate this information to the DC and all participating pilots
- d.** Take screen shots of match score screens
- e.** Send screen shots and write of up each match to DC

POC will be assigned the position of backup DC and be able to handle all appropriate responsibilities (as if were the DC is designing a battle plan and team strategy) including those responsibilities assigned for activity #1. However the POC will have the same level of command as a backup DC rather than simply a participating pilot.

Final Practical Exam

POC will be assigned the position of DC FFP CNR league match and be able to sufficiently handle all the duties and responsibilities inherent to this responsibility, including the selection and team work with a back up DC. If the POC's team is defeated in all matches of the FFP drop, he must take the DC position again until winning at least one drop within the match (although the match may be a loss).

If the POC's team wins at least one drop, he attain the rank of Lieutenant  and moves to permanent officer status.

If the POC's team wins two drops, obtaining a win for the entire match, he attains the rank of Captain  and moves to permanent officer status.
